## **Parkston School District Policy on** 1 **Enrollment, Transportation, School of Origin,** 2 and the Elimination of Barriers for Children or Youth 3 **Experiencing Homelessness including Unaccompanied Youth** 4 5 6 7 The Parkston School District policy is to: 8 9 ensure the immediate enrollment of children or youth experiencing homelessness 10 until all enrollment records may be secured, i.e. academic records, medical 11 records, proof of residency, or other documentation. 12 13 keep a child or youth experiencing homelessness in the school of origin, except when doing so is contrary to the wishes of the child's or youth's parent or 14 15 guardian. 16 17 ensure the elimination of stigmatization or segregated services and the elimination 18 of other identified barriers for homeless children and youth. 19 20 provide children or youth experiencing homelessness with services comparable to 21 services offered to other students in the school including the following: 22 23 Transportation services. 24 25 Educational services for which the child or youth meets the 26 eligibility criteria, such as services provided under Title I of the 27 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 or similar State or 28 local programs, educational programs for children with disabilities, and 29 educational programs for students with limited English proficiency. 30 31 Programs in vocational and technical education. 32 33 Programs for gifted and talented students. 34 35 School nutrition programs.

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
